How to get the most from these Top 100 Great Quotes On Life

- 1. Choose one Great Quote On Life every day (in any subject or topic of interest) and make it your own personal Great Quote on Life for that day.
- 2. Set aside a guiet moment to read and think about the guote.
- 3. Read the quote and then (after your initial reaction) read it again, more slowly. Ask yourself 'What are two key messages, questions or advice in this quote for me?
- 4. If you can't immediately see at least two messages then re-read the quote, think about the author, reflect upon how they came to write these words and ask 'what is the relevance for me?'
- 5. Write down the quote and any thoughts or ideas in a quote personal development journal. Keep it with you and add a new quote each day. This will grow to be a great personal development resource, a record of your progress and a list of action points and reminders for you.
- 6. Remember that just one quote can be the start of a new thought process, opportunity or indeed a phase of your life. They are there to be enjoyed and savoured.
- 7. Finally, always take the opportunity to share any quote with your family or friends. Pass on these wise words or inspiration to others.
